### Take the stand

While attending a class for people who want their home to be licensed to take in children for DYSF, a question arose "Who would take in a homosexual or a lesbian child?" I raised my hand because I believe that Jesus wants us to be that life changing agent in the lives of people who are in darkness. The Lord has called us to be a clear witness of his righteousness, love and forgiveness. I also realized that one must be called to that area, as I am thinking about this another question was asked, "Who has a problem with homosexuals and lesbians raising children?" I raised my hand and everyone turned to look at me. At this point I knew that I was set up by GOD to be that witness. As soon as my hand went up I was immediately attacked verbally by gay couples who were in the class. Statements were herald at me, but I stood my ground. I was asked why I believe that same sex men and women cannot raise a child when they can supply the need of that child in some cases better than a heterosexual can. My statement was, the child is in need of a father and mother, the mother is the nurture of the family, the father tells the child who he/she is, we cannot rewrite what is to be. I gave reason to consider my stand. I told them that during the summer I was throwing the football around to some of our boys, who attended our church summer camp, and it hit me because of the lack of fathers in the home, a simple game of catching a football could be so important to a little boy and build the right relationship between the two. At this time more comments of unbelief in the traditional family values were being shouted across the room. I told the class the child has enough issues in his/her life, having same sex couples raising them would only add to their problems. Single mothers have done a great job, but a father figure is still needed in a child's life. I stated that some of our young girls have not known an honest and true love that a father can give; she will not be able to see this in action when two woman or two men are raising this child. There were same sex couples there that took issue with what I was saying. They said that they love GOD and GOD knows their relationship with him so I could not judge them, my reply was that GOD does love you but it is the act of homosexuality he doesn't agree with .GOD must vindicate his word. A single mother spoke up and said,

" I agree with Terry because when I look into my daughters eyes I can see she needs her father, even though I'm doing a good job with her, she needs her father", and the whole class room came to a hush.
