WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT/TESTIMONY

Honoring your parents is a command for children of all ages. There is no exception clause in this command exempts the adult child from responsibility. Honoring your parents seem risky. Honoring your parents means forgiving them as Christ has forgiven you. It is an attitude accompanied by actions that say to your parents "You are worthy. You have value. You are the person God sovereignly placed in my life.
