The Training of the Will

Romans 7:18

For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh.

Living in obedience to the will of God makes supreme sense. His way isn't just the way to heaven; it's the best way to live on earth as well.

Then why do we struggle with obedience to God? The apostle Paul says its because of our sinful nature the flesh. When we insist on resisting the Spirit with the flesh, we get exactly what we want: our own way. Sometimes it is hard for us to learn how unpleasant this can be. While Paul was persisting in persecuting the followers of Christ, the Lord observed, You are only hurting yourself by fighting Me (Acts 26:14, NCV).

The prophet Isaiah described it like this: All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way (Isa. 53:6). In short, we have trouble obeying because we have a will that is contrary to Gods will. We resist Him and rebel against His commandments.

Sheep are not the only creatures that resemble mans selfish plight. Dogs do, too. I can see my response to God especially mirrored in the training of that special breed of bird dogs known as retrievers. They must all be trained to fetch and return to their masters.

Each special breed of retriever, however, responds to this training differently. The Chesapeake Bay retriever is one of the most strong-willed. Trainers must use a club to teach this hardheaded hound to obey the commands of his master. For the black Labrador, only the sting of a freshly cut switch is needed. And the golden retriever is the most sensitive of all, the trainer needing only his voice to train him. Evidently, his heart is tender to the tone of the masters' voice.

Like those purebred retrievers, we respond to our Masters training in different ways. Perhaps all you need to correct a bad attitude or habit is to hear a whisper of displeasure in your Masters voice. Others may need the switch or even the club. I know which one of the three is least painful.

The Curse of Comparison

Matthew 20:13

Friend, I am doing you no wrong; did you not agree with me for a denarius?

Do you ever struggle with envy? Envy can germinate in our souls when we decide to plant the seeds of comparison. It all starts with a prolonged look at what someone else has achieved or received. We compare what we know we have with what others appear to have. Generally, we can find a way to compare ourselves unfavorably with others. Envy has now taken root.

Jesus taught a parable about envy in Matthew 20:1-16. A landowner hired laborers for his vineyard early in the morning for a fair day's wage. Throughout the morning and even into the afternoon he hired more workers, promising to pay them "whatever is right" (v. 4). They agreed to his terms and went to work.

Later that evening he paid each laborer the same wage, regardless of how long they had worked. Predictably, those who had worked diligently in the scorching heat all day compared and grumbled, "That's not fair!" But the vineyard owner reminded them that they had agreed to work for what he had stipulated, and the money was his to do with as he pleased.

We become just like the "grumblers" when our limited perspective leads us to compare what we think we deserve with what others appear to get. The invariable result is envy.

Ultimately the choice for each of us is whether or not we truly believe that God is in control.

Ask God to help you realize when you are being tempted to compare and become envious. Pray for your spouse and yourself that you will learn to be content in all circumstances.
