

The Night Is Far Spent And The Day Is At Hand.

Joshua 10 :13

The Israelites were fighting the Amorites in Canaan. During the battle, Joshua prayed for the sun and moon to stop, so he would have extra daylight to finish the task. Scripture records that this prayer was answered: The sun “delayed going down about a full day” (verse 13). The very objects in the sky that the Amorites worshipped fought against them!

2nd Kings 20 9-11

God used this event as a special sign to show Hezekiah that he would regain his health. The sun’s shadow moved backwards by ten steps, probably five to six hours on the sundial. That is, the sun appeared to move eastward instead of westward. The conclusion is again the same, that such a miracle is beyond scientific explanation.

Genesis 1:16 16

And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also.

- God would never be subject to something he created. The universe or the constellations are the means by which we set our mechanisms for measuring time. National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST). NIST’s latest atomic timekeeper (there have been seven previous iterations) will lose just one second every 300 million years.
- God often speaks to us in our realm of restraint due to being subject to time. “Work while its yet day for nighttime cometh and no man is able to work” God is not under any such mandate not being subject to time but operates with us inside those boundaries. Abraham, Joseph, Moses etc. He has regulated everything to fulfill everything in your life in the right time. “Thus, be anxious for nothing” Your insinuating that something is missing in your life that should be there and God is off timing. If you have been here our brother would not have died” Martha
- Then God chooses to speak to us to be mindful of the realm in which we are going to for eternity. Jesus Christ was slain from the foundation of the world. Before the universe was created, before time existed, before man was created, God knew that we (in Adam) would sin. He knew we would rebel against our

Creator. And in the wisdom and love of God, in eternity, He predetermined a plan so that we could receive a free gift of salvation. In eternity, God planned for the Son of God to step into history to provide the ultimate sacrifice—the sinless Son of God would suffer sin’s penalty of death, be raised from the dead, thus providing a way of salvation.

- Adam sinned and he died in Gods dimension and perspective he is dead. 1 Timothy 5:6 King James Version (KJV) 6 But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth. Example: to point to the born-again experience Abraham and Sara had to be dead before life would come from them. Anything preceding was Adam whom God considered dead. Isaac was the promise in which the blood line promises the seed of Abraham Jesus Christ the 2nd Adam would come:

Romans 5:19 says —

“By one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.” “For the sin of this one man, Adam, caused death to rule over many...” “For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.”

1st Corinthians 15:22

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

- You were not a mystery when you were born, he knew you.
- “While we were yet sinners” so how we got here, by whom we got here, when we got here, God intervened into the process and knows you regardless.
- God plans incorporate our lack of cooperation, disobedience and circumstance to fulfill his message and purpose through us. Our pilgrimage is becoming vital to purpose and message.

Philippians 1-6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

- “Teach Lord to Number our days” Cause us to understand God has given us a certain number of days and we should apply the knowledge of God each day because we are in a dimension of restraint due to time.

Romans 13:12-14 New King James Version (NKJV)

12The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore, let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. 13 Let us walk [a]properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.
